The scholarship value is R70,000 per annum for two years for full-time study. Renewal after the first year is contingent on satisfactory academic progress. Students will also have opportunities for employment as research assistants.

Requirement: an Honours-equivalent degree or a 4-year professional degree in any discipline, or an MBChB.

- a cover letter describing the applicant's research and career interests and how these would be served by completion of the MPhil in Health Innovation;

- copies of all academic transcripts and certificates for previous degrees;
- the names and contact details of two academic referees.

Applications for admission to the MPhil degree must be submitted separately via UCT's online application system.
