



TB can affect ANYONE and DOES NOT distinguish between rich or poor. People with COMPROMISED IMMUNE SYSTEMS are largely affected. e.g. THE ELDERLY AND CHILDREN.

Ter herdenking van Wêreld Tuberkulosedag het die SATVI-span verskeie biblioteke in Worcester besoek om opvoedkundige praatjies, kunstiwiteite, storielees aan te bied asook om TB opvoedkundige video-materiaal te vertoon.

Van 24 Maart to 4 April is die program by Zwelethemba, Avian Park, Worcester (Waterloo) en Esselen Park se biblioteke aangebied. Elke biblioteek het ook afskrifte van 'n TB selflesende boek (Talking Book) ontvang as skenking tot hul boekvoorraad.

In commemoration of 2017 World TB Day, the SATVI team visited libraries in Worcester to present educational workshops, art activities, storyreading and screened TB educational material, to raise awareness about TB.

The program was presented from 24 March to 4 April at the Zwelethemba, Avian Park, Worcester (Waterloo) and Esselen Park libraries. Each library also received copies of a TB Talking Book (selfreading) as a donation to their material stock.




