MITRA means FRIENDSHIP.... So our latest housing is meant to cement new friendships amongst our students from all over the globe. The location is ideal – especially for those working in Observatory, Mowbray, Rondebosch, Claremonth, and the City even. It is close to the public transport routes, 5 min from Observatory train station and the My City Bus goes from Salt River station, which is a mere 2 stations away.

There are more or less 23 restaurants within close walking distance from our two units and our other houses are also a few min away only. Most restaurants, bars and retail shops are located along Lower Main Road, and there is a shopping complex and supermarket in St Peter's Square, a mere 10 min walk away, which is located below the historical 18th century Sir Herbert Baker designed medical school buildings of the University of Cape Town.

The first tenants will only move in on the 1st February 2019. Units 1 & 2 are marked in blue on the blow pictures.

Rental includes unlimited Wi-Fi connection, sewerage services, once a week cleaning of central areas, and TV. Filtered Borehole Water and Solar PV generated hot water and electricity are to separate costs monitored by smart meters. Quiet, non-smoking and no pets.



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
