


SUPER 3

AND THE SCARY INVISIBLE MONSTER





Layla, Themba and George were the best of friends.


They've been playing together since they could crawl!

She could climb giant walls and had perfect night-vision to watch over her friends and family.






Themba was... THE BRICKSLAYER!

George was THE AMAZING MR. TRIX!


He had the power of invisibility and could make snacks appear from out of nowhere!

They were told to stay at home so that the Coronavirus couldn't get them.


Teacher told them the virus was spread from one person to another in invisible droplets.

Soon the sadness turned into frustration and anger.


Why did they need to be locked up inside? Why couldn't they visit their friends? Why couldn't they play in parks?

So they talked about what they **could do** instead of what they could not do. Rather than being angry and sad all the time, they asked themselves,


"What would our superheroes do?"




They thought long and hard about it and came to the conclusion that being super actually means **caring about others**.


The most caring thing they could do was to try and make sure the invisible monster's droplets didn't spread!







Themba's Brickslayer superpower was not having the strength of a lion, but that he had the strength to play without his friends - just for the time being.
