The aim of the course is to help students bridge the gap between a Masters' degree and a PhD, especially if the Masters' degree was a clinical or professional degree with less of a focus on independent research and academic writing skills.

The outcome of this course is that students will have a very clear idea of what the PhD journey could look like. It will reintroduce participants to advanced academic writing skills and levels of scholarly thinking required to tackle a PhD. In addition the course should provide a firm understanding of whether they are ready for a PhD

There are 4 modules in this course, each lasting between 1 and 4 weeks, including an introduction and a wrap-up. Each module is designed around engaging materials and useful resources and assessments to gauge progress.

Students should make at least 6 hours a week available to get through the course material and assessments.
