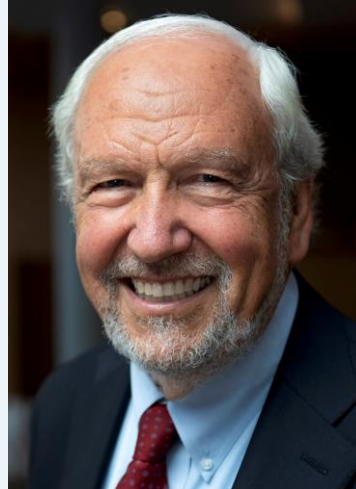

Prof Schwartz is the Director of the Center for Cardiac Arrhythmias of Genetic Origin and of the Laboratory of Cardiovascular Genetics at the Istituto Auxologico Italiano, in Milan, Italy. He is widely recognised the leading expert in long QT syndrome. His primary area of expertise is sudden cardiac death, including pathophysiology, risk stratification, therapeutic approaches, and underlying genetic mechanisms.
