PROF GREG BOGNAR

Prof Bognar is a Professor in Practical Philosophy at Stockholm University and a Senior Researcher at the Stockholm Centre for Healthcare Ethics (CHE). His research is in normative and applied ethics, especially bioethics and PPE (politics, philosophy, and economics). He is coauthor of the book The Ethics of Health Care Rationing: An Introduction (Routledge, 2014). In the 2019-2020 academic year, he was Laurance S. Rockefeller Visiting Faculty Fellow at the Center for Human Values at Princeton University. His research interests are in priority setting in health care, demographic change and population aging, public health ethics, human genetic engineering, and moral relativism.
