DEVELOPING NEW SOLUTIONS

The Hub allows for practical learning and skills development in innovation. Here, people come together to go from ideas to implementation.

Currently 8 teams are working on new solutions to improve health services.

The Hub serves as a connector between the public healthcare system and the broader community also, between health innovators and policy makers. The space will support meaningful interactions and inspire transformative relationships
