

## Prospective applicants for the MMed in Occupational Medicine degree

In selecting prospective candidates, the Occupational Medicine Division will require submission of a complete set of documents **prior** to being accepted for registration.

The application should include sets of documents listed below, which must be submitted via email to Mrs Lynne Harper at [lynne.harper@uct.ac.za](mailto:lynne.harper@uct.ac.za)

- A detailed **curriculum vitae** (including a list of publications and a description of your role in any unpublished research projects in which you may have participated).
- An electronic copy of **degree certificates AND academic transcripts** for previous degrees, which should indicate what courses you have completed and the mark achieved for each course listed.
- A **cover letter** that explains why you want to undertake a MMed in Occupational Medicine **AND** specify whether your application is for a **Provincial** (based on circulation of a Provincial advert by the Western Cape Government) or **Supernumerary** self-funded post (with evidence of financial support).
- Students from non-English speaking backgrounds will be required to take the **international TOEFL test** and provide evidence of the outcome in this regard. See also: [www.iapo.uct.ac.za](http://www.iapo.uct.ac.za).
- Evidence of registration with the Health Professions Council of South Africa as a medical practitioner.

Upon the receipt of the full documentation the committee will review the application and provide feedback within **two months** from the time of the application.
