

Prospective Applicants for the Postgraduate Diploma in Occupational Health (PG DOH) – 2025 Intake

In selecting candidates for the **Postgraduate Diploma in Occupational Health**, the Occupational Medicine Division will require an application for postgraduate admission and submission of requested documents through the following process:

Step 1: All prospective PG DOH students must apply for admission to UCT via the application process outlined in the link below. Please note the closing date of **31 July 2024** for all applications. No late applications will be considered. Link:

Applications need to be accompanied by:

- Curriculum Vitae including
- Full academic transcript
- Letter of motivation

Step 2: The Division of Occupational Medicine's administrator may then contact applicants to request the completion of an additional PG DOH Applicants Questionnaire to further outline professional experience and computer literacy skills.

Step 3: Following a detailed selection process, all applicants will receive feedback from the UCT Admissions Office regarding the outcome of their application.

Step 4: Successful applicants must indicate acceptance of the offer and inform the PG DOH Programme Administrator.
