The Award

This fully comprehensive scholarship provides full financial assistance for tuition, travel expenses, housing, food, books, and other expenses for the duration of the doctorate program. In addition to financial support, scholars will be provided with a comprehensive support network to ensure academic success.

Doctor of Public Health Program

Up to **Two** Mastercard Foundation scholarships will be awarded for the **Doctor of Public Health** starting in 2024-2025 academic year.

Eligibility Assessment for scholarship

The applicant MUST meet the following five eligibility criteria:

- Be a citizen and **currently residing** in a Sub-Saharan African country
- Be graduating or have graduated from a partner institution of the African Higher Education Health Collaborative with a master's degree (degree must be awarded by August 2024)
- Have **not yet started** studies at the doctoral level in a partner institution
- Be academically admissible to the Doctor of Public Health program https://www.dlsph.utoronto.ca/students/future-students/admission-requirements/
- Demonstrate a desire and commitment to return home following graduation to contribute to the ongoing economic growth and social development in Africa

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Step One
