## Pleural Diseases: What is new, fun and practice changing

Professor Lee is a recognised world leader in translational pleural research. His published work has challenged and disproved decades-old conventional practices, save lives, has cut morbidity and costs, improved QoL in many aspects of pleural diseases, and informed patient care worldwide. He was recruited to UWA in 2009 where he set up Southern Hemisphere's first pleural program at Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital. His clinical and laboratory training allow him to bring together clinicians, scientists and allied health colleagues to build a unique integrated program, known for its novel ideas and for challenging traditional teachings with vigorous scientific approaches.

Professor Lee's sustained high research output over the last 25 years produced 300+ publications. He has published six books including three editions of the Textbook of Pleural Diseases (the leading & most comprehensive pleural reference text) which has won the British Med Assoc Best Respiratory Text Award.

He has helped inspire global acceptance of Pleural Medicine as a new subspecialty, and has been instrumental in developing Pleural Medicine in Australasia and the Asia Pacific through collaborative projects, lectures, and training fellows/next-generation researchers, ensuring future progress.
